SUMMER CLEARANCE—The trade show dates are fast approaching and that means we need space to display all of the new canvases, threads, accessories and charts that we return with from these future markets. We will assist you in our clearance venture by offering discounts during the week of May $21^{st} - 26^{th}$ on needlepoint canvases, fabrics and lots of other merchandise.

MARKET EVENTS—There are two trade shows in the upcoming months. We are off to Columbus, Ohio in **June** for a convention center show that is primarily focused on needlepoint and knitting. We are looking forward to even more participation this year from the cross stitch segment of the industry. While new things are always being released, the focus for cross stitch will be the Baltimore show in **September**. We are fortunate that this market is returning here for a second year and look forward to having so many visitors from the needlework industry in Maryland and to our shop!

Specifically, the **Columbus** show is at the end of June and this is a market where we place orders for merchandise and it is delivered to us in the following weeks. The **Baltimore** show is a cash and carry market and all of the new from this event will be in our computer system and out on the floor for purchase on Saturday, **September 15th**. JUNE FRAMING PROMOTION—For those of you who did not realize we have a framing department or who have not had framing done in the shop, we are extremely fortunate to have two in-house framers. They are very talented, creative and always happy to help us in making suggestions on your mats or frame selections. As with everything else these days, the cost for framing continues to increase and we are grateful to all of you who bring your things to our framing department. Your finished works are both motivational and inspiring so we always look forward to seeing what will come thru our doors! We know you have a choice on how and where to finish your designs and we work hard to keep our prices as low as possible.

Winter this year brought unseasonably mild weather and early spring had some recordbreaking high temperatures. Those anomalies allowed us to be out and about doing things we might not otherwise be able to do with normal weather patterns. As a result, some of you told us that you did not accomplish as much stitching as vou had planned. We want to reward those of you who stuck to your goals, finished your works and are now ready to have your pieces framed! LIZZIE KATE—The last two double flips in the **Less=More** series are here. A new chart pack called **Bacon Bits**—the inspiration for these fun whimsical designs came from thoughts of the crispy trays of bacon that we munch on at the breakfast buffet in Nashville! **Spread the Love** is the next Inspiration Boxer kit

JUST NAN—Sun Blossoms Tree is the second in the charmed heart tree series—Love Birds Tree was the first and the third one will debut in August. Finchley's Summer House includes a beautiful hand-painted charm to embellish the house; Motif Mystique is a sampler of motifs and bright colors embellished with charms and beads

INK CIRCLES—Willow Berries; Rosetta; Love Letters:Fraktur is the third in this series and it is stitched with the Gentle Arts Wool. This thread is soft and wonderful to work with for cross stitch give it a try!



MIRABILIA—Santa is a new, elegant Father Christmas

BY THE BAY—Stitch an Inch Spring is the latest in these small 'inch' designs; Blueberry Hill

LITTLE HOUSE NEEDLEWORKS—The Summer Band Sampler, last of the four seasons has arrived and now it is very difficult to decide on a favorite! Quaker Birds and Sleigh Bells Ring are the latest in the ornament series for this year

FROM NANCY'S NEEDLE—Floral Star, Blue Hydrangea, Pinwheel Star and Silhouette are counted canvaswork designs

MILL HILL—The autumn kits (bead and button as well as the pin/ornament series) have already arrived! There are owls and witches, spiders and squirrels, a fall scene with a covered bridge and some sweet treats; **Debbie Mumm** has a new series of **Angel Girls**

SHEPHERD'S BUSH—New kits since market include Eve's Garden, a wonderful new sampler; All Seasons Fob, Eden's Lament is a pincushion

COUNTRY COTTAGE—Cherries and Berries, perfect for summer! The monthly cottages continue and the June Cottage is wonderful with strawberries and ladybugs—be sure to check these out and let us know if you want to be on auto for the series; Walk Before You Fly

MY BIG TOE—Normal Family; The Lord Bless You; Walk Humbly and Joy & Sorrow

NEEDLE DELIGHTS—Wine & Pine is second in the Double Delights series; **Samba** is a nice companion piece to **Rio**, which came out at Nashville—both use bright colors in geometric patterns

SUMMER HOUSE STITCH WORKES— **Calico Sampler** premiered in Nashville and the second part (D, E, & F) is the next release. This alphabet sampler has a different colorful band by each letter. Stitch the whole design as one or use the letters and do monograms or initials
